Assisted Living Lunch and Learn: Survey Preparedness and Plans of Correction

This State-Licensed only Lunch and Learn will guide Assisted Living, Home Plus, and Residential Healthcare communities through survey readiness and response. During this lunch and learn, Joan Hudson, KCAL Clinical Consultant will review how to prepare a survey ready binder/tool, how to complete a mock survey and focused reviews in your community, and the most commonly cited deficiencies as well as best practices to avoid these citations. Joan will also review how to write and work a plan of correction if your community does receive citations.

Learning Objectives:

- 1) Participants will understand the most commonly cited deficiencies in state licensed only homes and best practices to prevent them.
- 2) Participants will understand the state licensed survey process and be able to verbalize what is required upon entrance of a survey.
- 3) Participants will be able to write a plan of correction using a four-step outline for each citation.
- 4) Participants will have a full belly, laugh 2-3 times, and enjoy good company.
